

Responsibilities of Head Coach and Assistant Coaches Mineral Ridge Little Rams

- The Head Coach will be the only one allowed to make decisions for their squad. They are open for suggestions, but the ultimate decision will be made by the Head Coach.
- The Head Coach will determine their assistant coaches. Children are to listen and respect ALL assistant coaches as they do the Head Coach.
- The coaches are responsible for the children they are coaching. They are to have total control of the children at all times.
- The coach may bench any child who after three warnings does not obey the coach. Example: Disrespecting any adult who is coaching and trying to help another child.
- Practices are open or closed at the Head Coaches discretion with the Board consent. Parents and other observers of practice must not interfere with the practice schedule.
- The Head Coach will not punish a child for being late to a practice due to a parents work schedule or an unforeseen circumstance. All parents are to make every effort to have their children at practice and games on time.
- The coaches will treat all children equally. There will be no exceptions.
- If there is a problem that arises at a practice or a game the Head Coach is to bring it to the attention of the Board and make them aware of the situation. If the Head Coach is unable to resolve the situation, they are to bring it to the appropriate person: Cheerleading - Courtney Kelly, Football - Don Pugh. They will work to resolve the matter. If the situation still cannot be resolved, it will be brought to the Board to resolve.
